Payment terms

All curriculums are legally binding for one semester as soon as the customer has accepted the terms by answering the confirmation email. If the customer has not yet answered the confirmation email by start of the semester, the start is postponed until the terms have been accepted. Curriculums with 15, 13 and 7-8 lessons are payed monthly, the total sum equally divided into four months. Payment terms are 14 days and the invoice will be sent by email on the last Friday of each month except in December and June, when it will be sent in close connection to the final recital.

Example: You choose to follow the curriculum "15 lessons (full-time)", 45 minute lessons, the autumn semester of 2022. You receive an invoice of 1600 SEK on the 30th of September, the 28th of October, the 25th of November and a last one by the final recital in December.

Cancellation terms

The customer pays for each lesson within the chosen curriculum, whether or not the student chooses to attend them all. In case of the student being ill or cancelling due to other reasons, the student may choose either to take the lesson digitally or postpone it to a special occasion for "missed-out lessons" on a Saturday and Sunday towards the end of each semester.

I am not obliged to teach on other dates beside those specified in the semester overview, except if I myself should be sick or otherwise prevented from teaching. Then the customer is offered either to reschedule the lesson, or cancel it and have it refunded.
